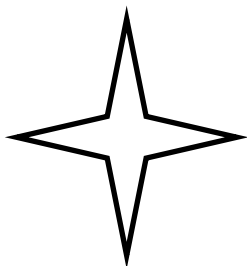




Tena Koutou Whānau

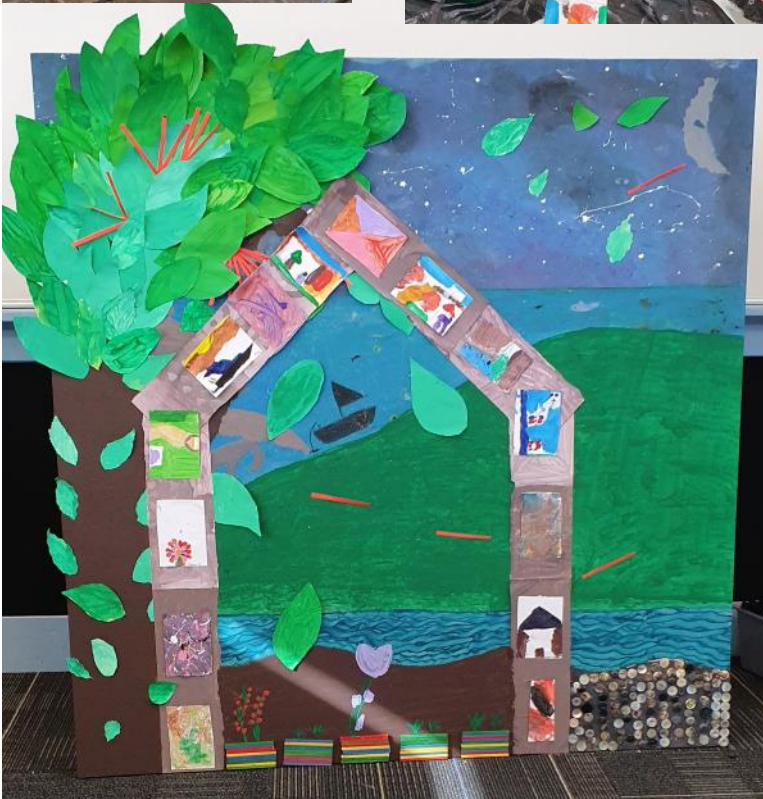
